

**MODIFICATION OF WASTEWATER REUSE PERMIT  
APPENDIX "A" TO PERMIT NO. LA-000215-02**

**Permittee Name:** City of Meridian

**Effective Date of this Modification:** March 1, 2011

**Complete Description of Modification**

The purpose of this Permit Modification is to add an allowable use of the Class A Municipal Wastewater produced by the City of Meridian.

1. Section E. Compliance Schedule for Required Activities, Page 6 of the Wastewater Reuse Permit, CA-215-02 shall be replaced with the following.

<b>CA-215-02 Runoff Management Plans</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• For the Class D effluent system, submit a Runoff Management Plan outlining measures to be used to satisfy the requirements of the Runoff/Wellhead Protection Requirements in Section F of this permit.</li><li>• Submit a Runoff Management Plan for reuse activities within the Class A Reuse Project Area. The plan should generally set forth measures to be implemented by the permittee to prevent and/or mitigate any runoff from sites irrigated with or otherwise utilizing Class A effluent, including visual inspections and procedures for documentation of responses to any runoff-related complaints received by the City.</li></ul>
<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Runoff Management Plan for Class D site due 60 days prior to effluent application</li><li>2. Prior to use of Class A effluent outside of Heroes Park</li></ol>	


2. Section F. Permit Limits and Conditions, Page 7 of the Wastewater Reuse Permit shall include the following use:
  - Commercial Carwash Facilities, with warning signs installed, adequate to notify the public that the water is recycled water and is not safe for drinking. Signs shall say "Caution: Recycled Water – Do Not Drink", or equivalent, in both English and Spanish.

The modification described above and referred to as Appendix "A" is hereby approved. This appendix to the permit is incorporated into and constitutes a part of Permit No. LA-000215-02.

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This appendix must be attached to the permit. The permit is incomplete and unlawful under IDAPA 58.01.17 *Reclamation and Reuse of Municipal and Industrial Wastewater* rules without this appendix attached.
