

Circa 1920: Transfer point from Shoshone Cr. (formerly Big Cr.) on NFCDA to railroad cars, Winton and Rosenberry Lumber Co.

1924: Splash dam at head of flume in Skookum Creek



1924: End of Skookum Creek flume at Little North Fork Coeur d'Alene R.




1924: Leiberg flume at Camp 6, log just splashed in.



1929: Winton Lumber Co. Dam at mouth of Leiberg Creek, Little NFCDA, taken from lower side. Built in 1928 by Jimmy Crotty. (Caption wrong? Breakwater Dam?)



1926: Little North Fork Coeur d'Alene River with log drive,  
between Camp 14 and Honeysuckle.

1924: Burnt Cabin Cr. railroad construction on Ohio Match Co. RR with Engine #4 and flat car full of section crew.



Circa 1932: Forest road construction on Grizzly Ridge in CDA National Forest.



December 1933: Idaho Northern (Union Pacific) Railroad Dept  
at Linfor, near confluence of Little North Fork and North Fork  
Coeur d'Alene during flood of 1933.



Early 1934: Large log jam on Little North Fork Coeur d'Alene R. after Dec 1933 flood. Jam from Pete Cr to Hemlock Flats (See Russell p 63).



1939: Aerial view of Beaver Creek Station CCC Camp, F-133



1962: Gabion "jetty" installations for erosion control along North Fork Coeur d'Alene.



1967: Road construction in forest. Series Burnt Cabin and ? Forks construction.



1980: "Beartrap" for erosion/stream stabilization above old Honeysuckle Bridge on Little North Fork CDA.



Circa 1960: Confluence of North and South Forks of the Coeur d'Alene River. (Note turbidity and coloration in South Fork Coeur d'Alene water compared to North Fork)
