Agency Reports

1. James reported on the National Water Quality Initiative (NWQI); there are 13 applications. Dixie Slough: 4 applications - 3 drip & 1 center pivot on pasture ground, Lower Sand Hollow: 4 applications - 1 drip, 1 center pivot & 2 wheel lines, and Outlet Lower Boise: 5 applications - 2 drip, 2 center pivots & 1 wheel line. James explained the new NRCS activity called "Edge of Field Monitoring". This activity would need to be located in one of the sub watersheds in our NWQI. This is an opportunity to work with a cooperating landowner in support of water quality modeling and/or credit trading verification with the minimum commitment of a 5 year contract with cost share.
2. Dan Steenson discussed the Idaho Heartland Coalition/Roger Batt and the JALC (Joint Appropriate Legislative Committee) imparities/impediments Water Quality Trading. Discussion on the TMDL Trading Frame Work Model. Henry will find TMDL Trading Frame Work for Dan.
